THOMPSON ISLAND VENUES

WATERFRONT LANDING

Panoramic views of the Boston Harbor and skyline will surely wow your guests at this charming and spacious pavilion with exposed beams, high open eaves, and interior lighting. This unrivalled beachfront setting accommodates up to 200 people.

OCEAN BLUFF PAVILION

The larger of our two main sites, our Pavilion tent offers two white frame tents with views of the Boston skyline framed by lush island trees. Arched entrances, vaulted ceilings, interior/exterior lighting, and inlaid floors make the larger tent an impressive venue for events for up to 280 people. Our smaller Olympic tent offers French windowed walls and warm interior lighting, making it an ideal venue for cocktail hours and dancing.

Rentals include bridal suite, round and long tables, low and high bistro tables, a sweetheart table, white garden chairs, Adirondack chairs, bistro lighting venue-wide, white linens, lawn games, boat transportation (round trip per guest), water station, Chinnet paper plates, plastic cups and utensils, day use of the Sherbrooke House and Executive Suite, and a beachfront bonfire.

At Thompson Island Outward Bound, we believe all children deserve access to expanded learning and the natural world. Our Island classroom is a place where every child can uncover new strengths and possibilities, moving from “I can’t” and “I’m not” to “I can” and “I will.”

Through our partnership with the Boston Public Schools, thousands of students in our Connections program board the ferry to an island classroom encompassing 204 acres of salt marshes, woods, campsites, labs, dormitories, and dozens of challenge structures.

Playing a crucial role in closing the achievement and opportunity gaps facing Boston middle schoolers, Thompson Island provides a safe and supportive outdoor learning environment, where children can advance their academic skills and build their capacity for perseverance, teamwork, and leadership.

Our core educational programs are provided at no cost, funded by a combination of philanthropy and the Island’s events business.
