THE BRIDAL SUITE

Included is a large private bridal suite with lots of natural light making is great for photos. It includes a private restroom, makeup and hair vanity, full length mirrors, garment racks, and lounge. Couples can access it starting two hours prior to event start time and until 30 minutes after the end of the event.

ADDITIONAL TIME

The venue fee includes 6 hours of event time up until 10:00pm. Additional hours may be added to the front of your event time and is \$1,000 per hour. Additional bar time not included. The hourly rate will be based on the selected bar package.

LABOR & EVENT MANAGEMENT FEE

The Labor & Event Management fee of 22% is applied to all events. This fee covers, staffing, catering labor, pre-event coordination and pre-event kitchen production.

A "Month of Wedding Planner" is required for all events.
