FEES

In addition to the space rental fee there are also museum event operations costs: *security, facilities* & *engineering*. The museum event operations costs are dependent on museum event space selection, number of vendors, expected attendance, etc. These costs will be estimated with additional information by your event manager provided by the event client.

CATERING

The Art Institute of Chicago has partnered with six Chicago- based caterers. These are the only approved caterers that are permitted for events at the AIC. Event clients will contract with the caterers separately from the event space rental. Please reach out to the caterers for information about pricing furniture rentals and planning services.

VENDORS

The Art Institute of Chicago requires all vendors to provide a certificate of insurance meeting the museum's requirements. Insurance requirements can be provided upon request.

The Art Institute does not provide audio visual services for external event rentals. All audio visual equipment and services will need to be provided by the event client.

The Art Institute has partnered with Five Star Valet as our exclusive valet vendor. Valet is available at the museum during normal operating hours. Please contact Five Star for information about pricing for after hours events.

INCLIMATE WEATHER

There are two available outdoor event spaces: McKinlock Court & Pritzker Garden. Inclement Weather back up spaces are not guaranteed. Please speak with your event contact to determine what is available.

WEDDINGS

Thank you for considering having your wedding at the Art Institute of Chicago. With a myriad of special event spaces ranging from traditional to modern, the museum offers endless options for your engagement party, rehearsal dinner, bridal shower, wedding ceremony, or reception.

Booking your wedding at the Art Institute of Chicago includes the following:

- Two hour rental of bridal or groom's suite to use as a holding space.
 - → Does not apply to bookings in Stock Exchange Room or McKinlock Court
- Use of museum coat check space (client will be required to coordinate staffing with chosen caterer)
- · 60-minute escort for wedding photos throughout the museum during scheduled event time
 - → Additional fee is incurred for photos taken pre-event, post-event, or on an alternative date

Additional Information:

• Earliest guest entry for events on an open museum day is 6:00pm. The museum closes at 5:00pm Thursday-Monday. Access for vendor setup would be granted earlier in the day.

- AIC requires that all couples getting married at the museum have a wedding planner for their wedding.

Event Rental FAQ

Does the AIC rent event space by the hour?

No, we do not rent event space by the hour or at half day rates.

Can I buy out the museum for an event?

Yes, please indicate that you are interested in the buyout to your AIC Event Manager. Museum buyout fee starts at \$75,000.

Can I rent gallery space with my event space rental?

Yes, please indicate to your AIC event manager which gallery you are interested in. We can also offer suggestions based on event space selection. In addition to a gallery rental rate, there are charges for the security staffing. Security staffing includes staff required for the path of travel to the gallery and the staff required to staff the gallery itself.

We do not permit the following in gallery spaces:

- Wedding ceremonies
- · Food and beverage

· Event rental furniture set up

What is the process for holding a date?

We offer a complimentary two-week hold on up to two dates for your event. After two weeks, your hold will be released. Your date is not officially booked until the contract is signed and deposit is received. Should another client inquire about a date you have on hold (within the valid hold window) - we will let you know immediately and you will have the first right of refusal.

Do you have in-house catering?

No, we do not provide in-house catering services. The museum has partnered with five exclusive Chicago-based caterers.

Can I use a caterer that is not an exclusive catering partner for the AIC?

No, we do not permit the use of caterers outside of our exclusive catering list.

Can I bring in my own alcohol or use donated alcohol?

All food and beverage is required to be provided by one of the approved caterers.

Is there a non-profit discount available?

Yes, we do provide a discount for non-profit organizations booking event space at the museum. Please indicate your non-profit status at the time of booking.

Where is the closest guest parking?

The Art Institute of Chicago does not provide any parking options. Event clients are welcome to send guests to the Millennium Garages located across the street or work with the museum's preferred valet vendors.

How late can my event go?

Events at the museum must end at 11:30pm, exceptions can be made on an event-by-event basis.

Can I host a ticketed event at the Art Institute of Chicago?

The AIC does permit clients to book events where they will be charging guests an admission fee or requiring guests to purchase tickets in order to attend the event. These purchases must be collected in advance. Onsite ticket sales are strictly prohibited. The use of a virtual link/QR code posted/displayed on museum property as a form of day-of payment is also considered an onsite sale and is not permitted.
