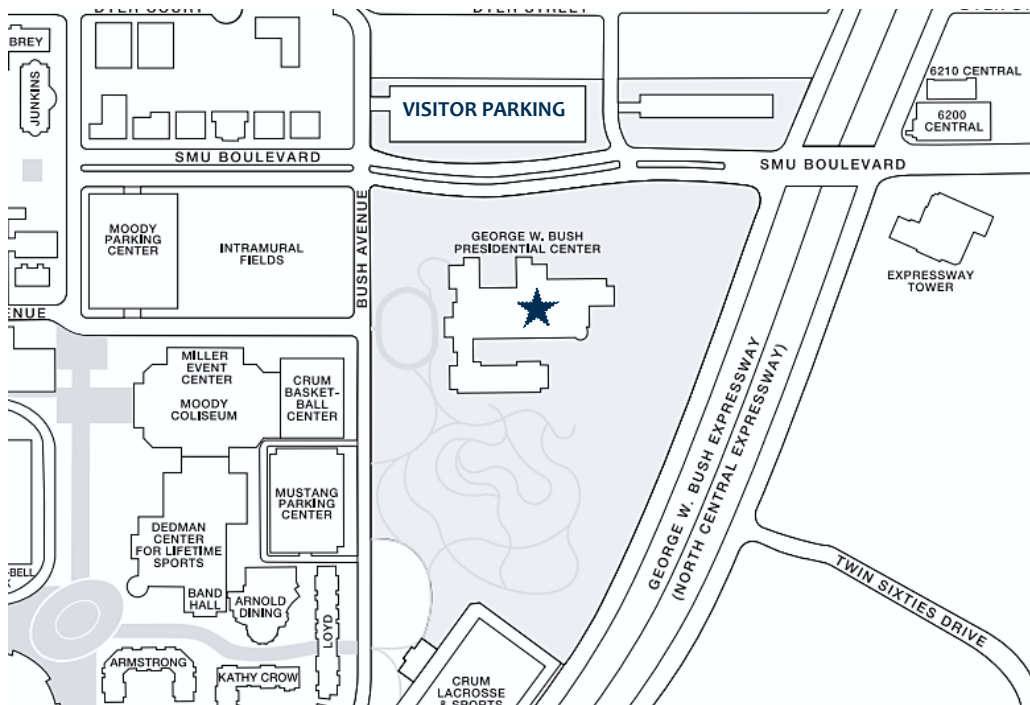

We are conveniently located in the heart of Dallas and nestled on a lush, 15-acre Native Texas Park on the campus of Southern Methodist University. The Bush Center houses three separate spaces where events can be hosted including the George W. Bush Presidential Library and Museum, the Bush Institute, and Café 43.

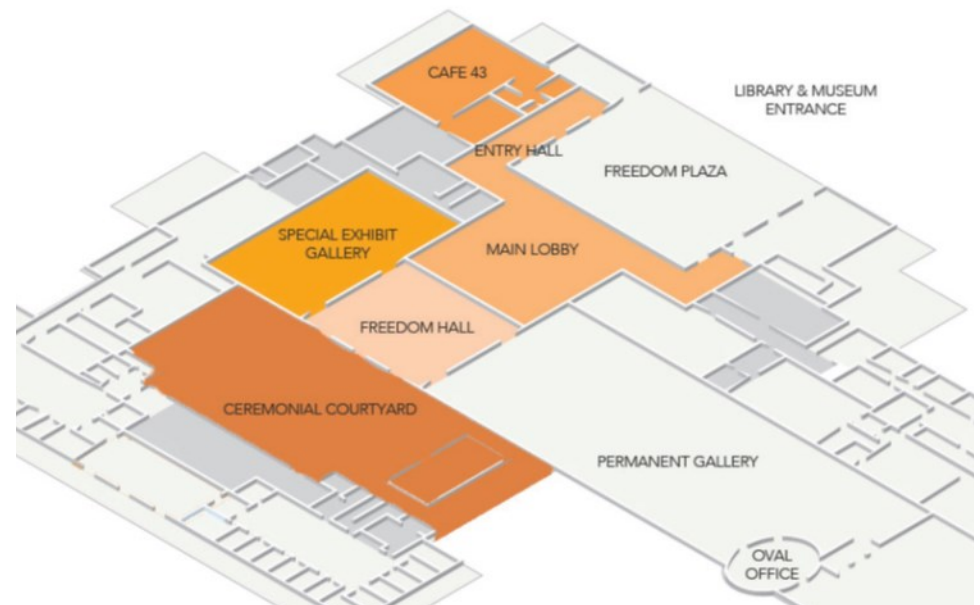


THE MUSEUM AND COURTYARD



History and opulence in one at the George W. Bush Presidential Library and Museum. The Museum's beautiful lobby showcasing a three dimensional sculpture of the presidential seal and a 360° bar sets the stage for guest arrivals. The lobby flows seamlessly into the grand, 67' Freedom Hall space and into the 5,000 square foot tented Ceremonial Courtyard.

Impress up to 300 guests for a seated dinner or up to 500 guests for a roaming reception in one of Dallas' premier venue spaces. Events can take place in this space from 6:30pm-11:30pm.





MUSEUM CAPACITIES & PRICING

MAXIMUM CAPACITIES

200 – Seated dinner in Freedom Hall (based on 60” rounds of 10)

300 – Seated dinner in the Ceremonial Courtyard (based on 60” rounds of 10)

500 – Reception style in Freedom Hall and Ceremonial Courtyard

FACILITY FEES AND FOOD/BEVERAGE MINIMUMS

Facility fees do include Museum admittance to the main exhibit gallery and special exhibit gallery (if available).

Any AV, tables, chairs, linens and tableware will be arranged through a third-party rental company. Your catering manager can assist with these arrangements and making vendor recommendations. Non-profit groups receive a 10% discount on the facility fee. The following rates apply to events taking place in February-May and September-December (facility fee discount available for January and June-August):

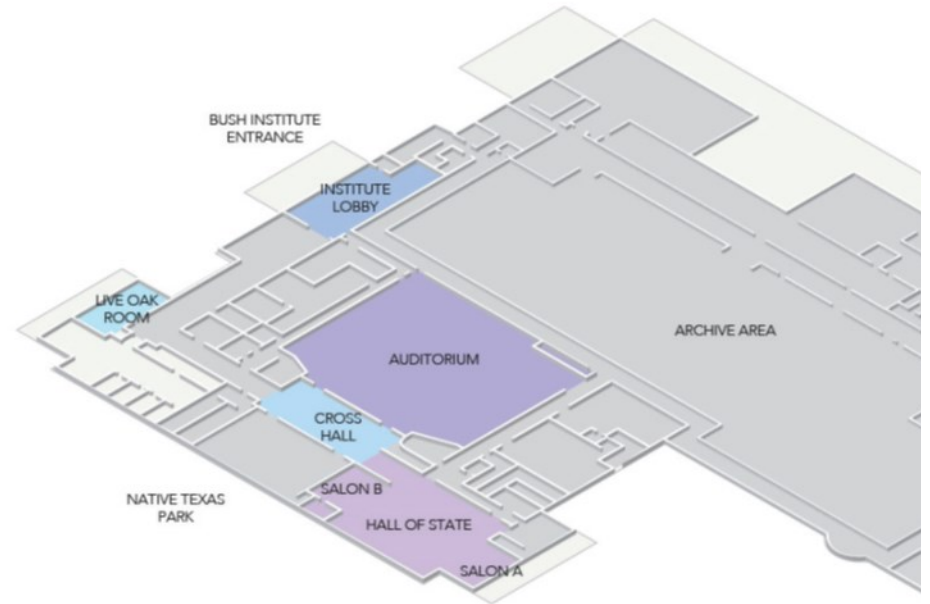
\$20,000-\$25,000 Food and Beverage Minimum

*Museum security is required from guest arrival until guest departure. Fees start at \$900 and are based on the group size and timing.

THE INSTITUTE



The Bush Center is home to the dynamic, public-policy arm, the Bush Institute. With high ceilings, airy walkways, and streams of natural light, the lower floor of the Bush Institute is closed to the public and provides a unique and presidential atmosphere you will not find anywhere else. As few as 10 or as many as 300 guests may gather for events from board meetings, luncheons, and conferences to stately receptions and elegant dinners. Events can take place in this space from 7:30am-11:30pm.

FACILITY FEES AND FOOD/BEVERAGE MINIMUMS

Facility fees include podium, 72” banquet tables, red banquet chairs, china, glassware and flatware. In-house AV packages are available by request. Please note the museum closes at 5:00pm, and all tours will need to take place prior to closing. Non-profit groups receive a 10% discount on the facility fee. The following rates apply to events taking place in February-May and September-December (facility fee discount available for January and June-August):

THE CAFÉ



Café 43, in reference to the 43rd President of the United States, has indoor and outdoor seating overlooking the native Texas landscaping, SMU campus and main entrance to the Bush Institute. The décor features beautiful artwork, including an entrance hall painting by Dallas artist Pamela Nelson, as well as an original piece by President Bush.

This intimate space flooded with natural light can accommodate up to 120 guests and is perfect for corporate receptions, private dinners, holiday parties and beyond. Events can take place in this space from 4:30pm-11:30pm.





CAFÉ CAPACITIES & PRICING

MAXIMUM CAPACITIES

96 – Seating in the full interior space with existing Café bistro chairs (up to 120 with rented chiavari chairs)

125 – Reception style in the full interior space

150 – Reception style in the restaurant and adjoining outdoor terrace

FACILITY FEES AND FOOD/BEVERAGE MINIMUMS

Facility fees include basic housekeeping services, existing Café bistro tables, 60” banquet tables, Café chairs, lap-length white linen, china, glassware and flatware. Removal of existing Café tables and seating is subject to a \$250 furniture moving fee.

Please note the museum closes at 5:00pm, and all tours will need to take place prior to closing.

Non-profit groups receive a 10% discount on the facility fee.
