

We prioritize sourcing Colorado-grown flowers whenever possible, supporting local legends like Stevens and Son Wholesaler, Arrowhead Farms, Blossom and Branch Farm, and the Colorado Flower Collective. And when a design calls for something a little more unique, we ensure every bloom—near or far—is the freshest and most beautiful it can be.



How we work.
We start with a complimentary consultation with one of our design consultants to talk through your vision, needs, and event details. From there, we'll create a customized design proposal and estimate with line-item pricing. Your event date will be held for 14 days after you receive your proposal.

To officially book with us, we require a signed contract and a 25% non-refundable deposit—if we don't receive both within that timeframe, the date will be released to other clients. Your deposit is applied to your final balance, which is due 14 days before your event.

We know plans evolve and tastes change, so you're welcome to make revisions to your design proposal up to three weeks before your event. Our goal is to make the process as seamless and stress-free as possible, so you can focus on the excitement of your event while we handle the floral details.



Vicing
We know pricing is one of the first things clients ask about, and while we'd love to give you a one-size-fits-all answer, every floral design is unique. Your final pricing depends on flower selection, quantities, seasonality, and design complexity. After your consultation, we'll provide a custom quote tailored to your vision and needs.

Delivery Minimums
From May through October—and on holidays throughout the year—we require the following minimums for delivery and onsite setup:

Denver and the front range: \$4,000 Larkspur and Clear Creek County: \$6,000 Colorado Springs and Grand County: \$7,000 Summit County and beyond: \$8,000
