### **Dexter Hall** | \$18,000

The Patricia D. Klingenstein Library boasts neoclassical architecture, stained glass windows, and soaring, 50-foot ceilings, a sophisticated backdrop for seated dinners, receptions and wedding ceremonies. Capacity: 300 reception, 200 seated

#### Gallery of Tiffany Lamps | \$18,000

The stunning Gallery of Tifany Lamps is an immersive display of 100 illuminated lamps, unbeknowst to many cocktail reception guests. *Capacity: 300 reception* 

## **Robert H. Smith Family Skylight Gallery** | \$10,000

The Skylight Gallery is an intimate space flooded with natural light, offering an elegant setting for intimate receptions and dinners. Capacity: 60 reception, 48 seated

#### **North Gallery** | \$15,000

North Gallery showcases historic treasures from our permanent collection through 15 glass cases displaying fascinating artifacts. Capacity: 100 reception

Rentals are based on a 5 hour event, with 2.5 hours of set up complimentary. Additional time can be purchased for set up and break down.

To close a gallery to the public when the Museum is open is an additional \$5,000 fee per space.

Non-Profits receive a 15% discounted rate on space rental fees.
