Entire Museum (Daily Buyout): \$12,000 -15,000

Museum Lobby, Courtyard and Living Room Gallery: \$10,000

Museum Living Room Gallery: \$8000

The Living Room is the premier event space and serves as a versatile and adaptable area for receptions, presentations, seated dinners and business meetings. Clients have the opportunity to take advantage of curated exhibitions to create a memorable evening for 150+ guests. The Museum's two Fine Art Galleries are adjacent to The Living Room and are available as an add-on for large events (see Buyout rate above).**

Museum Lobby and Courtyard (seasonal): \$6000

The Museum entrance and lobby provide a flex space that can accommodate guest check in or a small reception with access to our courtyard. The courtyard offers a lovely garden space for receptions under the stars and sky.
