Your wedding at Storm King Art Center is more than just an event; it's an immersive experience. From intimate ceremonies to grand receptions, our site offers a range of settings to suit every style and vision.

### **Important Details**

- To ensure every detail is meticulously planned and executed, we require couples to book the services of professional wedding planners. Our team can provide recommendations for experienced planners who understand the unique requirements of hosting a wedding at Storm King Art Center.
- While Storm King Art Center provides the breathtaking backdrop, please note that tenting, catering, rentals, power, and lighting all need to be brought in to accommodate your event. Our experienced team can provide recommendations and work seamlessly with your chosen vendors to help your vision come to life.
- Weddings at Storm King Art Center begin at 4PM, allowing you to exchange vows during the enchanting golden hour. Please note that all events must end by 10PM, due to the town's noise ordinance.

### **Membership Cost and Site Fees**

Hosting your event at Storm King goes beyond one evening, helping us provide groundbreaking exhibitions, conserving our collection, and offering a unique experience with art in nature for all our visitors. Venue rentals are a benefit of Membership, and venue fees are in addition, depending on guest count, location, and complexity of event.

### **Peak Season Fee**

A Peak Season Fee will be added for all weddings held on a Saturday in September through the second weekend in November. Peak fees range from \$1,500 for a ceremony to \$10,000 for a large wedding reception.

## Locations

### Museum Hill

Located around the Museum Building, a Normandy style chateau built in 1935, includes the Patio and Conference Room (additional fees apply). With sweeping views of the Northern and Southern parts of the Storm King property, with the Museum Building as a backdrop, this area adds the perfect touch of elegant ambiance to any event. Events held on Museum Hill have access to an outdoor restroom facility.



### South Fields

Open, rolling fields surrounded by native grasses featuring large-scale sculptures by artist Mark di Suvero, with stunning views of Schunnemunk and Storm King Mountains. When using this area, restroom facilities and additional generators will need to be rented.



## **Vendors / Rentals**

A recommended vendor list will be provided. Except for the tent rental company (Peak) and catering (Kitchen Sink, Beacon NY), the host has flexibility to select floral design, rentals, lighting, event planners, DJ/band, or any other outside vendor and should pay the vendor directly. All selections must be shared with SK for approval to ensure that they align with site standards.

All special event items and equipment must be rented from an outside vendor. Lighting is required for all events held after dark onsite. Please see our Lighting Requirements Document for more details. No open flames, loose flower petals, or anything staked into the ground. All vendors and hosts must provide Storm King with a certificate of insurance at least 14 days prior to the event for one million dollars with Storm King named as an additionally insured.

## **Inclement Weather**

As Storm King is an outdoor venue, all events require a rain plan – typically additional tents. Storm King must be notified no later than 3 days prior to the original event date about the possibility on enacting a rain date, which will incur additional fees.

## **Venue Fees\***

Your event at Storm King Art Center includes: a six-hour event rental, four hours of set up the day of the event, plus an additional 6 hours during a weekday for tent installation/ rental load in. Also included in the base fee is usage of the Museum Building Conference Room for seven hours the day of the event, one tram tour (up to 47 guests for one hour), use of up to 140 white folding chairs for your ceremony, and one-hour of golf cart usage for couple photography.

If you require additional time outside of the above stated time windows with the golf cart, the conference room or the use of more than one (1) tram, the following additional fees will apply:

- Event Time - \$1,000 per hour
- Load In/ Load Out - \$1,000 per hour
- Tram Tour - \$400 – 47 Guests per Tram – Two Trams Max
- Golf Cart Usage - \$500 per hour
- Conference Room - \$500 per hour

## **Payment**

Requested dates will be held for one week after your site visit without a deposit. Events have the following schedule of payments:

- Payment 1 – Membership Fee in Full – To book date
- Payment 2 – 50% of Estimated Site Fees – Due three months before event
- Payment 3 – 50% of Estimated Site Fees – Due two weeks before event
- Additional Payment 4 – One Week after Event – Any additional fees incurred

Cancellations made within 10 calendar days of the event date will result in the refund of Payment 3 (50% refundable site fees) only. Upon cancellation, Payments 1 & 2 will be credited towards the required Membership level, and the remaining amounts will be converted to a donation (fully tax-deductible).
